What do we provide?

East Ayrshire NHS Podiatry provides a specialist service for the people of East Ayrshire to assess and treat foot problems.

We prioritise the care of foot wounds and ingrown toenails with bacterial infection to help maximise patients' health, well-being and mobility.



We work with Nurses, Doctors and Surgeons as part of multidisciplinary teams in order to take the best care of the people of East Ayrshire.

Nail cutting.
Fungal toenails.
Thickened or curved nails.
Routine corns and hard skin.
Verrucae.
